

# Personalized Preschool Education at The Montessori Academy of Arlington

What do you want for your preschool aged child? In addition to challenging academics, does it include confidence, independence, respect for others, responsibility, problem-solving and decision-making skills?

At The Montessori Academy in Arlington we believe that children learn best in an environment that allows them to move at their own pace academically, make decisions for themselves, solve their own problems, learn to respect others and be an active member of a classroom community.

Preschool classrooms are three-year communities of three, four and five year old children. Children and parents love this concept as it develops nurturing, leadership and mentoring skills in

children and promotes a strong relationship with classroom teachers.

Credentialed Montessori teachers personalize instruction to meet the needs of each student. In math, hands-on materials replace worksheets to help children gain an understanding of the underlying processes. Early reading skills are nurtured by introducing letter sounds in families, such as (s, m, a, r, t, b), rather than in alphabetical sequence. Beyond a strong emphasis on reading, math, writing and science, enrichments include art, Spanish, gardening, conflict resolution and community service.

Awareness of other cultures is nurtured through monthly continent studies which include stories, cooking and art activities.
